The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. Any arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.

Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff, and Overhead - \$2,490

This fee represents a proportionate share of our operating costs necessary to provide your family with the best facilities and services that we can offer. Our services include: conducting the arrangement conference, planning the funeral, consulting with family or responsible party, obtaining and filing permits and authorizations, coordination with clergy, cemetery, crematory, or other third parties, and sheltering of remains. Our overhead include: proportionate share of operating costs including, but not limited to, taxes, licenses, utilities, fees, insurance, and staff salaries. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming - \$795

Embalming and disinfecting of remains, cosmetology and any required restoration, except in special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Direct Cremation - \$2,490

Reduced Basic services of our funeral director and staff, funeral home overhead, transfer of remains to the funeral home, sanitary care of remains, transportation of remains to crematory. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials. The containers we provide are constructed of cardboard and/or flake board. This charge does not include any rites or ceremonies.
